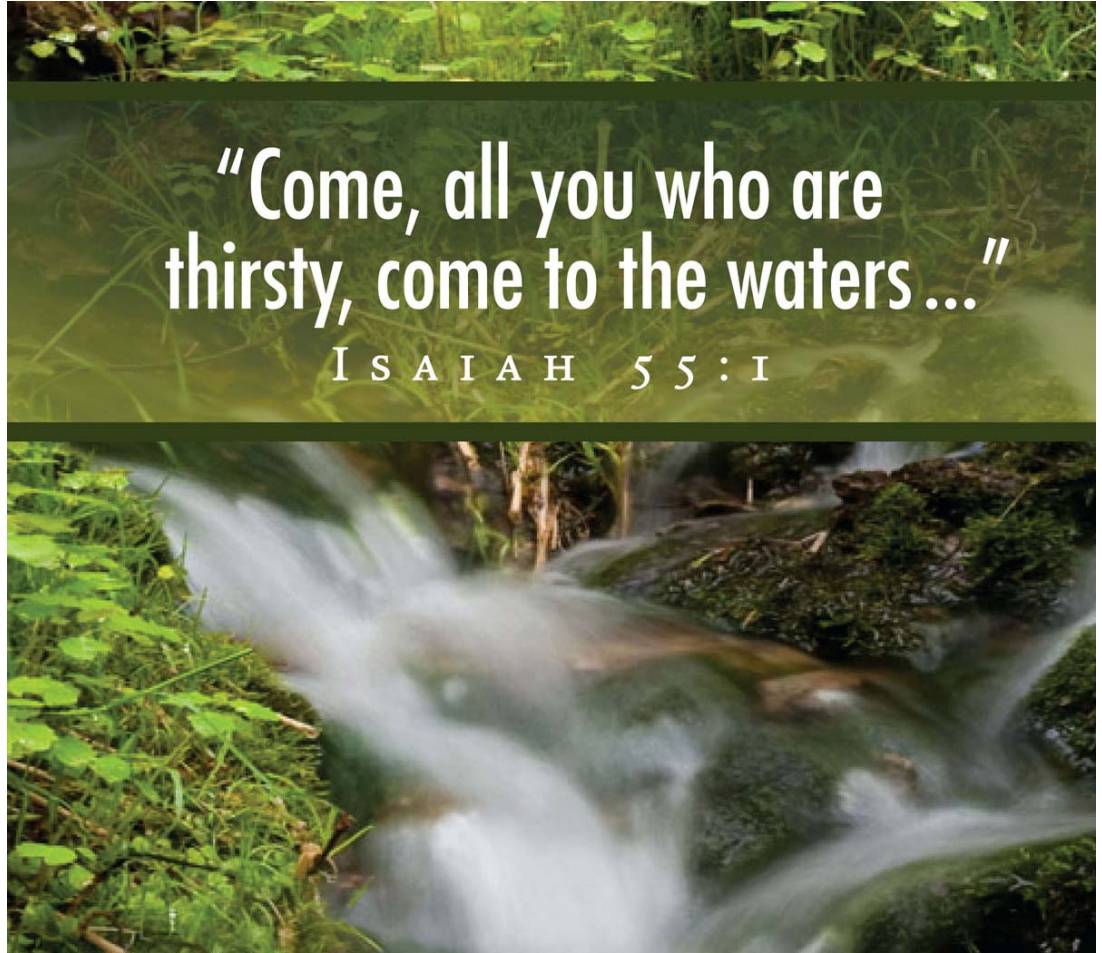

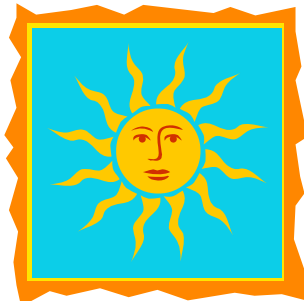

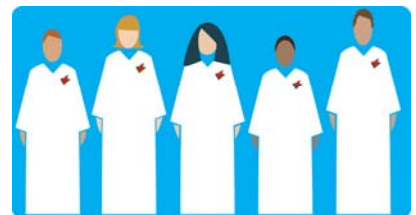
***Revelation 1:5b-6***

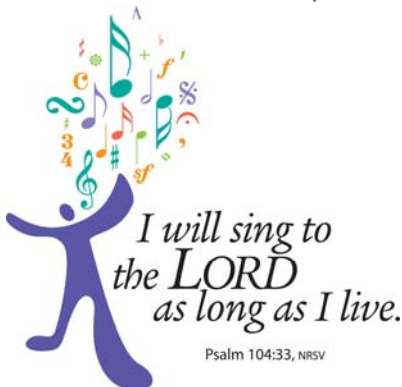
## Gee Creek – Thrivent Projects
